Opioids are not needed to manage most types of pain after a dental procedure.

Opioid pain medications are addictive. These include hydrocodone (Vicodin[®]), codeine, oxycodone (OxyContin[®] or Percocet[®]), tramadol and morphine. Get educated about how pain medicines affect your health.
