

# SHOULD YOUR CHILD BE IN A BOOSTER SEAT? MEASURE NOW!

While booster seat maximums vary, it will never be lower than 4' 4".

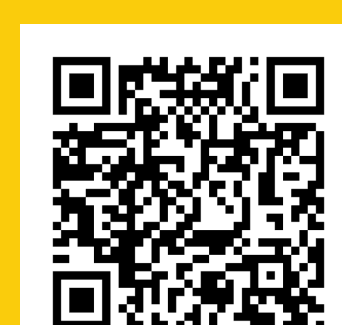

If your child is above the red line, they may not need a booster seat anymore. Contact a fitting station coordinator to know for sure.

## DELAWARE'S CHILD RESTRAINT LAW HAS CHANGED

New guidelines have been put in place to ensure your child's safety on the road. The change in the law includes the requirement that children must remain in booster seats until they reach the height or weight maximum listed by the booster seat manufacturer. Although height maximums may vary, it will never be lower than 4' 4".
